

Genus *Phosphoribacter*

Etymology

[Phos.pho.ri.bac'ter] *Phosphoribacter*, referring to the type genus *Phosphoribacter*; -, ending to denote a genus;
N.L. neut. pl. n. *Phosphoribacter*, the *Phosphoribacter* genus

Nomenclatural type

Genus “*Phosphoribacter*”

Description

Rod shaped bacterial genus from sludge. Likely utilises a range of substrates including sugars and amino acids, is capable of polyphosphate accumulation and cycling.
