Etymology

[Car.tha.go.ni.bac'ter] N.L. n. *Carthago*, Carthago nova or Carthago spartaria, nowadays known as Cartagena, city in the southeast of Spain; N.L. masc. n. *bacter*, rod; N.L. masc. n. *Carthagonibacter*, bacterium from Carthago Nova, a city close to its isolation place
