Etymology

[Bi.na.ta'ce.ae] N.L. masc. n. *Binatus*, type genus of the family; *-aceae*, ending to denote a family; N.L. fem. pl. n. *Binataceae*, the Binatus family

Genus *Binatus*

The family constitutes a monophyletic lineage as described and defined in Parks *et al.* (2018). The family contains the genus *Binatus*.
