[Wu.kong.ar.chae'um] N.L. n. *Wukong*, a legendary Chinese figure, also known as Monkey King, who caused havoc in the heavenly palace; N.L. neut. n. *archaeum*, from Gr. adj. archaios ancient, archaeon; N.L. neut. n. *Wukongarchaeum*
